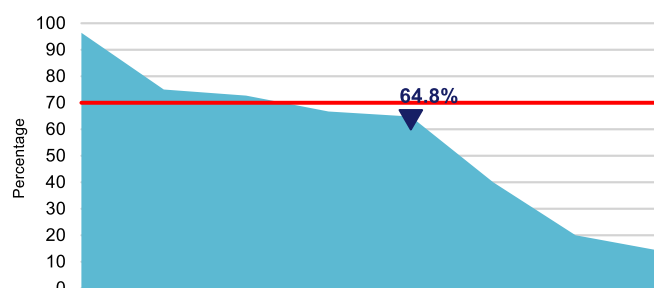

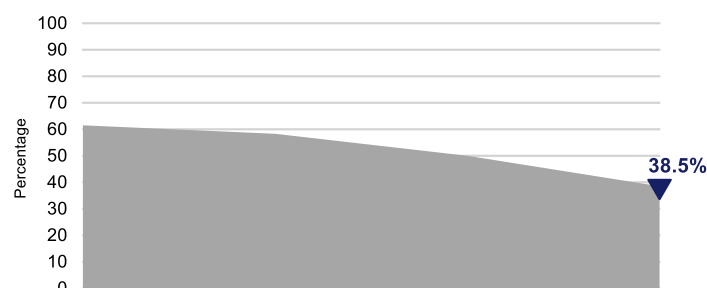

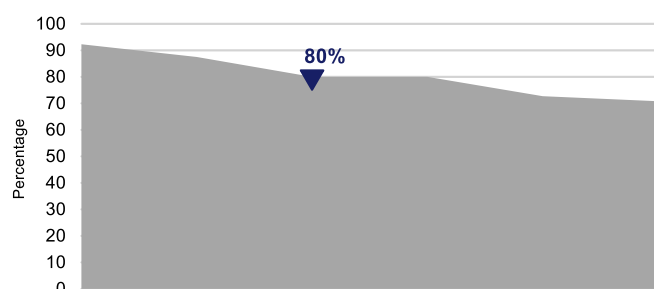
Time from referral to episode start (benchmark)
