Report dashboard – 1 January to 31 December 2023



Profile of patients who completed a referral questionnaire (n = 92)

65%	female	12.5	average age (years)
6%	Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander	11%	living in area of highest disadvantage
67%	had pain for more than 12 months	50%	outside healthy weight range
44%	carer work impairment due to child's pain	3.8	average school days missed last 2 weeks

70% patients with at least moderate pain severity

88% patients with impaired health related quality of life

87% patients with at least moderate functional disability

6% patients taking opioids daily (excluding codeine)

Services provided in this period

92 patients started an episode of care

43 patients assessed by a multidisciplinary team

62 patients started a treatment pathway

508.4 hours of in clinic care

109.3 hours of telehealth

Median wait time from referral to episode start **43.0 days**

Average length of episode of care **358.4 days**

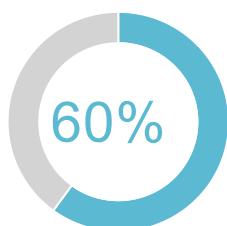
Average treatment time per episode **13.5 hours**

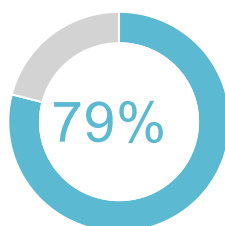
61 patients completed an episode of care
